- In Steam flows to Irrigation Scheme at Collinsville
- Connections via Hail Creek to Moranbah
- Alternative to BMP duplication
- >1000 MW of Pumped Hydro and 1.3 GW of Solar

WHEN it comes to North Australian water infrastructure, new modelling is pushing for the Government to think big.

A report by the Bowen Collinsville Enterprise Group said a large-scale Urannah Dam would be viable, reliable and deliverable, but only if \$1.46 billion was poured into the water schen

The report predicted that a 150,000 mega litre dam would produce \$1.70 in regional benefits for every \$1 spent on its construction

But to make the \$673 million dam economically viable, the government would need to double the project's budget to build the additional infrastructure. To be economically viable the report suggests a large scale dam needs to be built, connected to \$200 million irrigation and \$592 million pipeline

infrastructure The dam would carry a hefty price tag of \$1.465 billion, with annual running costs of \$15 million.

A smaller dam would save more than \$200 million in capital costs, but the report warned that descaling the dam to 70.000 mega litres would result in the project losing 10 cents to the dollar

AN INLAND ocean bringing to life up to 30,000ha of fertile Queensland farmland is shaping up as an economic life saver for one of the state's most depressed regions.
